Federal Law Enforcement Training Centers (FLETC) is presenting the **Active Shooter Threat Training Program** in **Dodge City, KS** which is a **FREE course**. FLETC covers the cost of the course and training materials. The Department or Officer is responsible for travel, lodging, and meals, etc... **This is a four-day (32-hour) course**, designed for the police officer, and is described as follows:

*The Active Shooter Threat Training Program (ASTTP) is designed to provide the student with the knowledge and skills to successfully handle an active threat event. This program will provide the student with the proficiency and aptitude through hands-on training to manage these situations. The program takes Active Shooter Threat Tactics Training to the next level utilizing dynamic interactive drills and scenario based training. This program is an intensive training program that covers a variety of tactical subject matters to include: Individual and team movement and operational formation. In addition, this program focuses on the role and responsibilities of the responding officers. **Officers will also get a portion of the Tactical Medical Course and be given the free items below:***

*Individual First Aid Kit which includes Two tourniquets, chest seal, combat gauze and trauma dressing, case to hold the items and belt carrier for one tourniquet.
(over a \$150 value)*
